Students with first teaching fields in History, Journalism, Political Science, Social Science Comprehensive, Art, English Comprehensive, English and American Lit., French, German, Spanish, Speech Communications, and Theatre Arts/Drama must complete courses in this area.

Courses selected from AST, BIOL, ENV, GEOL (geology), CHEM, GEOG (physical geography only) or PHYS.

At least one laboratory course must be taken.
