Transfer students may gain admission eligibility into PreNursing (PRN) via several routes. If the transfer GPA is 3.00 or above and the prerequisite course work has been completed with the required grades, the student will be admitted into the basic baccalaureate pathway when class space is available. If the transfer GPA is 2.50-2.99, students must complete a minimum of 9 credits at UNLV core requirements or prerequisite course work as part of the course work to establish the required admission GPA of 3.00. If the transfer GPA is 2.00-2.49, students must complete a probationary contract in which 15 UNLV core requirements or prerequisites course work must be completed with a 3.00 GPA to remove the probationary status and contribute to the establishment of the required 3.00 admission GPA. Students are eligible for admission to the nursing major (NURS) when a UNLV GPA of 3.00 is established and the student has earned a grade of "B" or above in the prerequisites identified with an asterisk and earned a minimum of a grade of "C" or above in all other general education and prerequisite courses. **Students must complete a separate application to be admitted into the Nursing program. For acceptance into the Nursing program, the "B" grade in the identified courses (\*) must be earned in either the first or second attempt in the class (This includes audits and withdrawals as attempts). Students who have not achieved a grade of "B" after the second attempt will not be considered for admission to the Nursing program for a period of three years. Students must also have completed the Nursing Entrance Test (NET) and achieved a score at or above the national mean to be eligible to apply to the Nursing program. Also, NURS 299 (meets Multicultural requirement)^ must be taken at UNLV for a student to be eligible to apply to the Nursing program.**
